	GRANDPA GROUPEL – THE FISH WITH GLASSES ACTIVITY: WINDOW ART

Lesson:

Assistant needs time for taking attendance and receiving offering
Introduce self
Storytelling by Don Arends

Craft: Fish Window Art

Supplies:

Fish Pattern (can be Christian fish symbol) – one for each child
Window Art Paint-in bottles. Do not put on palettes
Plastic Ziplocs – 1 for each child

Instructions:

- Explain that the fish is an old symbol for Christianity, and will also remind us of Grandpa Grouper.
- Have the children put the fish pattern UNDER one of the Ziploc bags.
- Use the Window Art Paint to color in the picture of the fish on the plastic bag. They may use different colors than on the original.
- The paint needs to **completely color in** the picture, and all paints must meet the surrounding paints. Otherwise it won't stick together when taken off the plastic.
- To take this home, place the Ziploc bag on a paper/Styrofoam plate and carry carefully.

This art must be handled carefully. It cannot be folded or placed up against something it can stick to (except a window) even when dry.

When the paint is dry, peel it off the Ziploc bag and place it on a window.

If you want to wrap it for a Father's Day gift; when it is dry, place another plastic bag on top of it to keep it from sticking to the wrapping paper.

Prayer: Dear Father in Heaven, Thank you for fun fish stories, and for teaching us to help others. Thank you for Fathers and for Father's Day to honor them. Let this window art Christian symbol fish remind us of you daily. Amen
